RCAT – Rutgers Comprehensive Alcohol and Traffic Education and Enforcement Program

NextBus

Rutgers buses are fitted with satellite tracking systems designed to keep you on schedule. NextBus can predict vehicle arrivals with a high degree of accuracy using Global Positioning Systems (GPS).
